To bid them farewell... in the month of September*

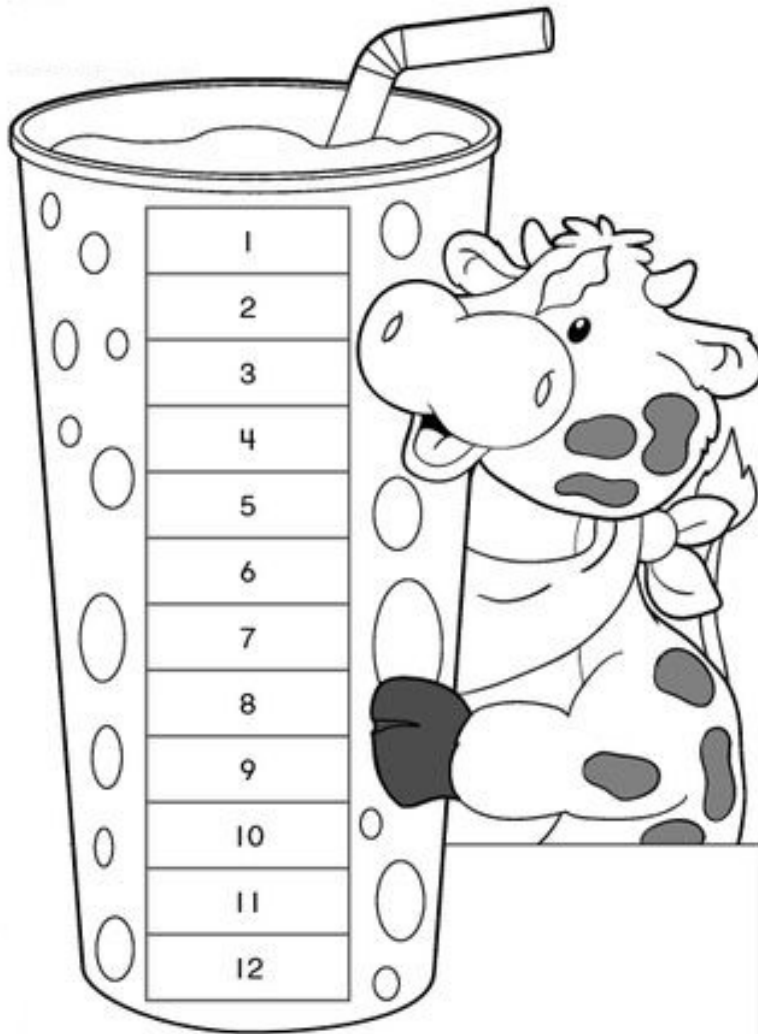
*When the leaves turn orange, and the winds grow cooler,



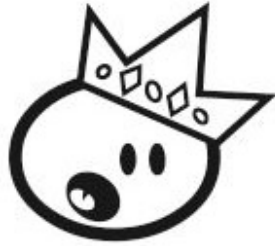

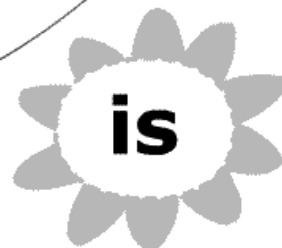
